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Meet Conditions

1. The competition will be held under A.S.A. laws and technical rules. All entrants must be registered members of their association and of an affiliated club.
2. Entry forms can be downloaded from www.chaseswimmingclub.org.uk Club entry must be by electronic entry file, using Sportsystem software. The file can be obtained by emailing meetsecretary.chasesc@gmail.com. All entry information, including ASA number and date of birth, must be checked to ensure accuracy before submission. Incomplete entries will not be accepted.
3. Entry fees are £7.50 per event for electronic entries. The entry fee for individual entries will be £8.00 to allow for the extra administrative costs.
4. Entry times must not be faster than the published upper qualifying times (see separate document). Entries may be checked against the British rankings and any swimmer found to have a ranking time that exceeds the entry time before the date of entry will be excluded from the event, without refund. All entry times must be short course, actual or converted to a 25m pool. It is the responsibility of all competing clubs to ensure that entry times are accurate.
5. Strictly no entries will be accepted once all the entries are published. Once accepted entries are published NO changes to any swimmers events will be made.
6. Once entries have been submitted either by club or individual we are unable to change them for a subsequently achieved faster time.
7. Swimmers with a disability are welcome to enter and will be included within the able-bodied programme. A certificate of swimming disability will need to be given to the referee before the event.
8. In the event that an individual event is oversubscribed, entries will be accepted on a first come, first served basis. No entries will be accepted on the day of the meet under any circumstances. Chase Swimming Club reserves the right to include up to two Chase Swimming Club competitors per event, with no time. All swimmers entering this licensed competition must comply with the upper qualifying times.
9. All individual and club electronic entries plus payment (one bank transfer per club please), must be received by the promoter by the closing date of Saturday 15th March 2025 midnight. We reserve the right to close the meet early if it becomes



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10. The promoter reserves the right to refuse an entry. Incorrect or incomplete entries will not be accepted. All accepted and rejected entries will be posted on the Chase Swimming Club website prior to the event. **Please notify us of any errors as soon as possible.** Rejected entries will receive a full refund. Once entries have been accepted, no refunds will be given unless supported by a valid doctor's certificate or in the case of swimmers being selected for national, regional, or county events on the days of the event. Refunds will be processed as soon as possible.
11. A secondary strobe light will be used for starts, where it is requested by an athlete at the time of entry, subject to availability at the pool.
12. To allow for smooth running of the meet, any withdrawals should be made by 12 noon, Friday 4th April 2025 by emailing meetsecretary.chasesc@gmail.com, stating competitor name, club and event number.
13. All events will be seeded on submitted entry times, with the slowest heat first and all events will be heat declared winners.
14. Over the top starts and backstroke ledges may be used.
15. It is the responsibility of coaches and team managers to ensure that their swimmers report to the marshalling area in time for the start of their race.
16. Results may be displayed during the meet and Live Results will be published on the Chase Swimming Club website during the meet.
17. Medals will be awarded to the first three places, in each age group, per event. Medals will be awarded to disability swimmers who PB in the events they enter and, where more than one swimmer competes under the same disability classification they will be ranked accordingly. Medals can be collected from the medals' table when announced.
18. The Female category is for birth sex females in accordance with Swim England's Transgender and Non-Binary Competition Policy. By entering the 'Female' category, a swimmer confirms that their birth sex is female.
19. Confirmation of warm-up and start times of each session will be posted on the website.
20. Coaches and team managers are expected to supervise their own swimmers during the warm-up, following the published schedule.



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- 19 The supervision of swimmers at all times is the responsibility of the club with which they have entered, or of their parent/carer if entered individually. This particularly applies during breaks between sessions and in areas where Chase Swimming Club cannot monitor activity, such as showers, changing rooms and public areas.
- 20 Poolside passes are available for coaches and team managers supporting competing swimmers at a cost of £15 and includes breakfast, lunch and refreshments. Passes should be ordered prior to the meet using the application form and can be collected on the day. Passes must be worn at all times when on poolside and in designated swimmers' areas. It is the responsibility of attending clubs to ensure that poolside passes are only issued to people who have an up-to-date DBS and they are adequately staffed in terms of Swim England ratios. No parents will be permitted to enter the poolside.
- 21 Matt Davenport will be present during the meet taking photographs.
- 22 Chase Swimming Club takes no responsibility for loss or damage to personal possessions during this meet. Swimmers, coaches, team managers and spectators are advised to keep their belongings in a safe place at all times.
- 23 The programme will be available on the website to download.
- 24 Any conditions not covered in the above will be at the discretion of the promoters, Chase Swimming Club.
